





RIVERSIDE DRIVE TRAFFIC CALMING PROJECT QUESTIONNAIRE

Many of you will have attended the Riverside Drive work session on March 14th, 2001 at Capilano College. This session revealed that the community's top three concerns were:

- 1. Speeding
- 2. Inadequate or unsafe sidewalks
- 3. Parking

Traffic Calming is defined as the combination of mainly physical measures that reduce the negative effects of motor vehicle use, alter driver behaviour and improve conditions for non-motorised street users. All of the issues raised in the workshop have been documented for inclusion in plans and budgets as resources permit. The scope of the current Traffic Calming project is to specifically address speeding. The past experience using a reduced speed limit and police enforcement was not successful and did not have a lasting effect.

Our budget allows us to now proceed with some Traffic Calming options to slow traffic, provided there is sufficient community support for this approach. The results of this survey and other feedback will be made available to the Community.
